ORDER

UPON CONSIDERATION OF the motion filed by the Alaska Electrical Pension Fund, International Union of Operating Engineers Local 793 Pension Plan, and the Firemen's Retirement System of St. Louis (collectively, the "Pension and Retirement Funds") for appointment as lead plaintiff and approval of selection of counsel, and good cause appearing therefore, it is hereby ordered:


1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The Pension and Retirement Funds are appointed Lead Plaintiff pursuant to 15 U.S.C. §78u-4(a)(3)(B)(iii).
3. All securities class actions against any or all of the defendants subsequently filed in, or transferred to, this District shall be consolidated into this action. This Order shall apply to every such action, absent an order of the Court. A party objecting to such consolidation, or to any other provisions of this Order, must file an application for relief from this Order within 10 days after the

action is consolidated into this action. This Order is entered without prejudice to the rights of any party to apply for severance of any claim or action, with good cause shown.

4. The Pension and Retirement Funds' selection of Robbins Geller Rudman & Dowd LLP and Saxena White P.A. as Lead Counsel is hereby approved, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. §78u-4(a)(3)(B)(v). Lead Counsel shall have the following responsibilities and duties on behalf of Lead Plaintiff and the putative class: (a) preparing and filing pleadings; (b) briefing and arguing motions; (c) conducting discovery proceedings and depositions; (d) settlement negotiations with counsel for defendants; (e) pretrial proceedings and the trial of this matter; and (f) the supervision of all other matters concerning the prosecution or resolution of this action.
